***This list highlights a selection of some of the best and largest private schools in the San Antonio area and is intended to serve as a helpful starting point for families exploring educational options. While it is not a comprehensive list of every private school available, the schools featured are widely recognized for their strong academic programs, established reputations, extracurricular opportunities, and overall student experience.***

### **Keystone School – San Antonio**

*119 E. Craig Place, San Antonio, TX 78212*

Teachers have an average of 20 years of teaching experience. 19 AP courses. 7 sports along with girls basketball who recently won an area championship. Outdoor Education at all levels supports and enhance classroom instruction. Senior year students travel to Yosemite National Park.

### **Geneva School of Boerne – San Antonio**

*113 Cascade Cavern, Boerne, TX 78015*

Average class size is 18 students. 10 AP courses & 21 honors courses. 51-acre campus. Geneva has won 12 state championships in fine arts. 19 sport teams with 29 State Championships since 2008. All seniors complete an oral presentation of a Senior Thesis to graduate.

### **Providence Catholic School – San Antonio**

*1215 N. St. Mary's Street, San Antonio, TX 78215*

All-girls institution. 11:1 Student teacher ratio. 12 AP and 5 dual enrollment courses are available. All Providence students participate in community service activities. 20 clubs and organizations including fitness council and Provet TV news team. 8 high school sports. Comprehensive visual and performing arts program.

### **Saint Mary's Hall – San Antonio**

*9401 Starcrest Drive, San Antonio, TX 78217*

The student to teacher ratio is 15:1.20 AP courses and 53 national merit finalists over the last 4 years. More than 20 student organizations on campus including Junior State of America and Model UN. Upper school student complete 60 hours of community service.

### **San Antonio Christian School – San Antonio**

*19202 Redland Road, San Antonio, TX 78259*

Average class size of 13 students. 62-acre campus. 24 hours of service to a non-profit per academic year. Over 30 Honors classes and 8 AP & Dual Credit courses. 35 athletic teams with 14 sports. 17 fine arts classes with additional electives in journalism and broadcast journalism.

### **Central Catholic High School – San Antonio**

*1403 N. St. Mary's Street, San Antonio, TX 78215*

All-boys institution. The median GPA is 3.73. 14:1 student-to-faculty ratio. 17 AP courses. Over 30 clubs and organizations. 12 athletic teams.

### **Antonian College Preparatory High School – San Antonio**

*6425 West Ave, San Antonio, TX 78213*

8 academic clubs, 10 service clubs, and over 20 special interests clubs. 17 AP and 40 Honors courses. 36+ clubs & organizations. The Band, Dance and Cheer programs have National championship teams.

### **St. John Paul II Catholic High School – San Antonio**

*6720 FM 482 New Braunfels, Texas 78132*

The average class size is 10 students. 11:1 student-to-teacher ratio. 95% student participation in athletics and extra-curricular activities. 19 on campus sports with 9 sports state championships since 2009.

### **The Atonement Catholic Academy – San Antonio**

*15415 Red Robin Road, San Antonio, TX 78255*

18 is the average class size. 5-10% of seniors earn National Merit recognition. 8 AP courses are offered. Students collectively earn more than \$2 million in scholarships each year. Music program has earned superior performances at competitions. 9 athletic teams.

### **TMI Episcopal – San Antonio**

*20955 Tejas Trail W., San Antonio, TX 78257*

Founded in 1893. 30% of students are cadets in JROTC. Designated as one of the highest ranked JROTC program in the country. The school offers a boarding options for 5 or 7 days. About 50 students are boarding. 21 AP courses are offered. 26 athletic teams and over 30 clubs and organizations.

**Incarnate Word High School - San Antonio**

727 E. Hildebrand, San Antonio, TX 78212

Specializing in faith-based, college-preparatory education for young women, the school emphasizes academic excellence, leadership and service. The curriculum integrates rigorous academics with diverse extracurricular programs, competitive athletics and leadership opportunities to foster holistic development.

**St. Mary Magdalen School - San Antonio**

St. Mary Magdalen School is a bilingual, dual-language Catholic school that focuses on faith, academics and service. This school offers a Graduate Support Program, which fosters high school and college readiness among its middle school students.

**St. Anthony Catholic School - San Antonio**

Offers a well-rounded, faith-based education from early childhood through middle school. The Katherine Ryan Early Childhood Program (KRP) features STEM integration, small class sizes and a Spanish immersion option. Elementary and middle school students benefit from a rigorous curriculum that includes advanced math, technology, fine arts and music, paired with spiritual growth.

**Bracken Christian School - Bulverde**

489 student enrollment with a 9:1 student to teacher ratio. Your children will not only learn academic concepts but will also grow in their faith, character, and understanding of who God created them to be.

**First Baptist Academy of Universal City**

307 student enrollment with a 6:1 student to teacher ratio. The Academy, three year old through 8th grade, is an out-reach ministry to families in the greater Randolph area and surrounding communities regardless of church/spiritual background. The purpose of its high school, however, is to disciple young believers as they grow to Christian maturity therefore all high school students must have a testimony of a specific time they accepted Christ as their savior.

**New Braunfels Christian Academy - New Braunfels**

636 student enrollment with a 12:1 student to teacher ratio. New Braunfels Christian Academy is dually accredited for Kindergarten through grade 12 by Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and by AdvanceEd, formerly known as Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACS/CASI).

**The Christian School at Castle Hills - San Antonio**

802 student enrollment with a 11:1 student to teacher ratio. Serving students from infants to 12th grade in academics, athletics, and championship fine arts. Routinely, Castle Hills classes score more than two years above national averages on standardized testing.
